Lillee Jean Trueman is an American actress, director, filmmaker, writer, producer, and model. Lillee Jean is best known for her award-winning celebrity talk show Lillee Jean TALKS! Live, featuring award-winning Hollywood stars Donny Most, Shelley Wade, John Callas, Staci Layne Wilson, Chick Allan, Lady Clegg, and Neil D'Monte. The show has been awarded twice at indie film festivals for Best Podcast (Pageant Film Festival), and Best Web-Series (Gothamite Monthly Film Awards).

Her acclaimed sci-fi comedy indie film, 'The Trapper Trap - The Rise of Princess Glamourite', has won dozens of awards for her creative flare boasting Best Actress nominations and wins (Elegant International Film Festival, Cine Vista Oasis Film Festival), Best Costume Design (Gothamite Monthly Film Awards), and Best Trailer (Critics' Choice International Film Festival, CinePlay International Film Festival).

From the streets of Paris to Athens, Lillee Jean's indie rom-com film, The Chorus in Our Eyes, has led her to several Best Actress nominations and wins from the Clown International Film Festival, Athens International Monthly Art Film Festival, FusionFilm IFF, Global Visionaries IFF, and Spring Time International Film Festival. Her micro-short film, The Mission is Complete, Angelique, has also garnered significant recognition, being named a Finalist at the Silverlens Film Awards.

Lillee Jean's current television work includes HBO's (HeyDey Productions LLC.) "The Gilded Age" S3, as well as a recurring guest-star role (March-May, 2024) on 'The FNL Network Talkshow' (finalist of the Taste Awards Festival Awards), where she was awarded a Special Achievement Honoree award for the Entertainment and Lifestyle News category. In 2025, Trueman signed on to direct the best-selling book-to-TV series "Write to Kill." The series will be filmed in iconic locations across London and New York with a Hollywood cast.

Debuting in 2024, Trueman directed and produced the viral cyberbullying and stalking documentary film, Project Bullyish. The gritty documentary boasts a Finalist Award from Humro Film Festival, an Official Selection Award from Filmnest, and an Official Selection Award from KIFFF for Best Feature Documentary, screening abroad.

Continued philanthropic work includes working alongside Choose Today, through a powerful video and photo campaign, and joining the UNFCCC in spreading awareness about climate change. In 2021, Lillee Jean teamed up with Inspiring Girls, for their #Thislittlegirlisme campaign. Trueman went on to have Miriam González Durántez as a guest for Lillee Jean TALKS! Live, discussing female empowerment. Furthering the reach for girls to have a better future, Lillee Jean met with Inspiring Girls Panama to discuss female empowerment, and, a girl's power to ability and succeed.

She is known for her trademark big blue/green eyes with central heterochromia, red hair, high cheekbones, and full lips, which define her unique appearance. Through 2022-2024, Trueman acted in several commercials for the Israeli brand, Adah Lazorgan.

Raised in New York City, she is Ashkenazi Jewish and Lutheran, and her ethnicity spans Russia, Ukraine, France, England, and Germany. She is a trained actress, with predominant studies outside of film work, at the prominent T. Schreiber Studio in New York City. There, Lillee extensively studied the Meisner Technique with Nicolas Kane Landry, and various British dialects with Page Clements.
